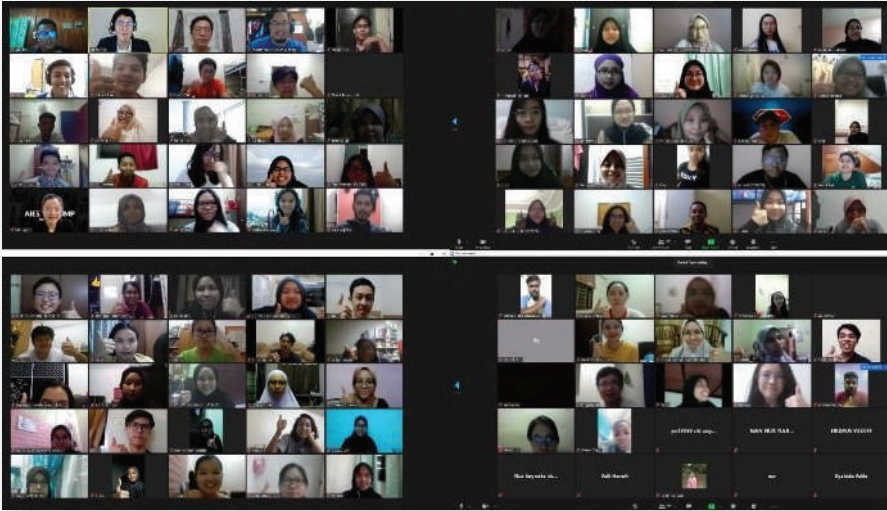

CPDC has organised online career development activities and programmes for UMP students during the pandemic for upskilling and reskilling.

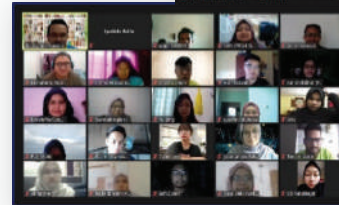


## CPDC Career Workshop 2020. Speaker: DR Resume Services. 04 & 18 November 2020.

- The students improved their skills in using Microsoft Excel for studies and future needs.

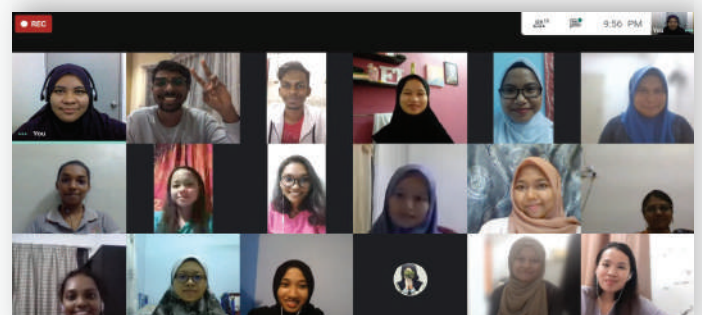


## Students Virtual Visit to Top Glove Corporation Bhd. 29 July 2020.
